Sealed Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Rosebud Sioux Tribal Treasurer's Office** located at **11 Legion Avenue, Rosebud, SD 57570** until **Wednesday, October 26th, 2022 at 2:00 PM** local time. At that time the **Sealed Bids** received will be transferred to the **TECRO Office** located at **306 Buffalo Pass Lane** where they will be publicly opened and read shortly after 2:00 pm. Submittal of the Bid shall be in accordance with Article 14 of the Instruction to Bidders.

The Project includes the following Work:

- **Furnish and Install approximately 3,103 LF of 6" diameter, and associated service lines;**
- **Furnish and Install valves, flushing hydrants, and other metal joint fittings;**

The Rosebud Sioux Tribe reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive informalities, or accept any bid or combination thereof which appears to serve the best interests of the Tribe.

American Iron and Steel
