The following becomes a part of the original project manual and drawings, taking precedence over the items that may conflict. The bidder shall note receipt and make acknowledgment of the Addendum on his/her bid form, incorporating its provision in his/her bid.

PROJECT MANUAL

The following additions, changes and clarifications have been made to the Project Manual.

Section 00410 - Bid Form,

Remove Bid Form and replace with revised attached Bid Form.

Clarification: One item (#33) was added and the description of item #20 was changed. Service saddles shall be 4"x1" with 1" corporation stop. A 1" threaded x 1.5" brass compression fitting shall be used to transition to 1.5" PVC service pipe. The cost of the compression fitting shall be included in Bid Item #20.

Section 00520 - Agreement,

Article 4 - Contract Times

Delete Paragraph 4.02 A and replace with the following:

A. The Work will be substantially completed on or before <u>July 31, 2020</u>, and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions on or before <u>September 13, 2020</u>.



Section 32 9200 - Turf and Grasses,

Part 3 - Execution

Replace line 3.3 A.2 with the following:

2. Fall: September

DRAWINGS

The following additions, changes and clarifications have been made to the Drawings.

General Clarification

Service saddles shall be 4"x1" with 1" corporation stop. A 1" threaded x 1.5" brass compression fitting shall be used to transition to 1.5" PVC service pipe. The cost of the compression fitting shall be included in Bid Item #20.

All temporary water services shall be removed during the winter. During the winter construction shutdown, existing customers need to either be connected to a new portion of the water system or served from their existing service by the old water distribution system.

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ARTICLE 1 – BID RECIPIENT

- 3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:
 - A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, and any data and reference items identified in the Bidding Documents, and hereby acknowledges receipt of the following Addenda:

- B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if

- any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.
- F. Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.
- J. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 4 – BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION

4.01 Bidder certifies that:

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 4.01.D:
 - 1. "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process;

- 2. "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
- "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and
- 4. "coercive practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the e execution of the Contract.
- E. The prices bid herein include sales tax and all other applicable taxes and fees.
- F. The goal for DBE/MBE participation on this project is 1% and the goal for WBE participation on this project is 4% of the total dollar value of the construction contract. The bidder shall submit a fully executed Disadvantaged/Minority Business Enterprise Assurance Form (Part C of the Special Provisions) with this Bid Proposal to indicate the DBE/MBE and WBE goal achievement and/or good faith effort.
